



Grown Together is a parenting hub which has been set up as a charitable trust and we are offering parenting programmes for families, we currently offer toolbox courses for teen years, primary year and the preschool years, these are run in a six-week block and covers all of the important topics of parenting.

We run Space which is for babies of 0-4 months and this is a 19 week course and covers all of the important topics of the first year of life whilst providing a safe space for whanau.

Game on for Dad's is a parenting course run by dad's for dad's this is six weeks.

The courses all come with a cost however we are partnering with local business in the community and are working towards offering these courses heaviliy subisdised or free of charge for all whanau. We hold the parenting courses at the Connect Centre in Rothwell st however are really happy to host at schools if parents would feel more comfortable attending.
