


### Learning Assistant vacancies at Gleniti School

Gleniti School is seeking applications for four permanent Learning Assistant vacancies.

These roles involve working with students and teachers to support pupil learning. The base hours for each position are 10 hours per week.

### Key Responsibilities

As a Learning Assistant, you will be primarily responsible for providing support to teachers in assisting and guiding pupils' learning.

Core tasks include:

Working with students to deliver a variety of tasks in the classroom as directed by the teacher.

- Assisting students to stay on task and complete work.
- Monitoring and observing students.
- Supporting inclusion in school and amongst peers and taking appropriate action to support students' wellbeing.
- Working to build trusting relationships with students and colleagues.

Additional tasks may include providing support for students with specific health or behavioural needs, or performing simple tasks related to personal hygiene, feeding, and monitoring. You may also be required to support students at break times as required.

Employment terms are as per the Support Staff in Schools' Collective Employment Contract.

### Core Skills Required

Successful applicants will demonstrate:

- Listening, patience, empathy, encouragement, resilience, calmness, tact, initiative and professional integrity.
- A commitment to supporting and encouraging the use of te reo in the classroom.
- Experience in the role or a similar role is valued and preferred.


