COLOUR WALK-A-THON

Thursday 29th February 1.30pm

Weather: Cloudy 19



What's happening: Teachers will bring children, with their bags and drink bottles to the field at 1.40pm. Every child will have an iceblock stick (this is how we keep count of laps done). At 1.45pm our event will start. The children will walk laps of the field for around 1 hour, passing through 7 colour powder stations and one water sprayer station. After each lap, our parent helpers will mark the children's iceblock stick.

At 2.40pm we will finish and children will sit in class groups. On presentation of their stick, laps will be counted and total written on the child's hand, in return they will be given a lemonade iceblock. Children may be collected from the field at 3pm.

What to wear: (children come to school in mufti)

- White clothing, this could be a white tee, whole white outfit.
 Black clothing works too.
- · Sun hat from home
- Sunglasses or goggles (optional to protect eyes)

What to bring:

- Drink bottle named (children will bring to field)
- Towel (optional)

Powder is made from non toxic cornstarch and water soluble dye.
